

EANS tumour section report 2018

The tumour section has continued to build on its strategic vision for development that was articulated in our last report. Progress has been made in each of the three key areas identified by EANS section members:

Newsletter

The newsletter is thriving with a good selection of articles covering a range of topics. At this stage sufficient articles are being submitted for the next several editions. The editor Michael Bruneau, has a clear strategy to continue broadening the appeal for section members and to promote the newsletter more widely. Section members and beyond continue to be approached for their ideas and articles to ensure continued sustainability

Webinars

Our first successful webinar featured Prof Duffeau discussing the surgical management of low-grade gliomas. The event was oversubscribed and further webinar are being planned based on engagement with our members to provide topic areas to prioritise.

Annual section meeting

The first section meeting was very successful in Venice and covered a range of topics. A second section meeting will focus on the management of cerebral metastatic disease at the EANS meeting in Brussels.

Administrative support for the section is provided by Lucinda Foster. She has been very proactive in engaging with section leaders to support and promote events and initiatives to the section membership and beyond.
